PADI Rescue Diver is the most hands-on and challenging novice diving class.

Rescue Diver will help you not only self-rescue, but also help another divers in the event of an emergency. You will learn CPR, search and recovery skills, master the tired diver tow, learn how to approach and control a panicked diver situation, perfect the ring toss, and conquer the most serious, yet fun, PADI program. There are two parts of the **PADI Rescue Diver Course** conducted over two weekends. Part one is in the classroom and pool. Along with guided learning at home with textbook and DVD. The first weekend is held in the classroom and pool with your PADI Instructor. Part one can be completed year-round. Part two is in the open water at Glennies Pond, a local rock quarry. There are four rescue scenarios to be completed. Part two can be completed May through October.

Requirements:

- Must have completed Open Water and Advanced Open Water Diver Training
- Successful completion of a sanctioned CPR course within the past 24 months.
